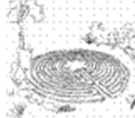
We give thanks for the lives of all of those whom God has called to himself, especially those whom we have loved and lost, but for a while.

Give thanks for all churches dedicated under the patronage of All Saints.

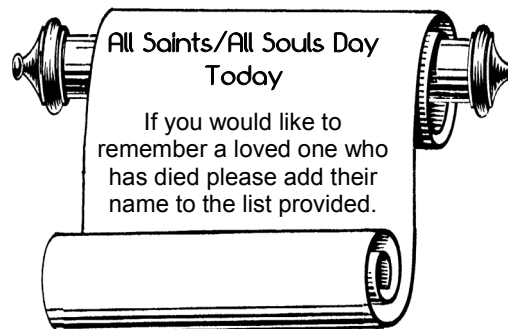
