Please join us in the hall for refreshments after the service.



## Sunday 11th March 2018 Fourth Sunday in Lent

Psalm 107 recites how God has saved people from difficult situations. In the section selected for the Eucharist today, we are told by the Psalmist that 'Fools were far gone in transgression: and because of their sins were afflicted'. Those fools, of course, are us, and because of God's intervention in our lives we should praise God's saving grace towards us

- Let us thank the Lord for his goodness: and for the wonders that he does for us; Let us offer sacrifices of thanksgiving: and tell what he has done with shouts of joy (cf. vv 21-22)
