It requires attendance at the Synod Service on the Wednesday evening, then Synod in session Thursday and Friday nights from 7pm-10:30pm, and Saturday from 10am-5pm (and yes, it's always a bit of a marathon!). If you're elected this year, the period of service will be for three years, as each synod spans three years. Our many thanks to Sally Petty and Felicity Wiltshire, who have been our synod reps for the last three years.
