Leaders* - Reporting Child Safe Concerns at St Margaret's

If a report is made to you as a Leader:

•Listen without interupting or giving opinions.

- •Check that steps have been taken to ensure the child's safety.
- •Check if the police have been called.
- •Let the person know you will support them to go through the process of reporting.
- Report to Priest in Charge or Child Safe Officer, or Wardens.
- •Child Safe Officer and Wardens will consult with the Priest where available, unless the Priest is the subject of the complaint.

• Priest/Child Safe Officer will call DHHS 1300 360 391 and Kooyora 1800 135 246 and if appropriate the Police.

- •If necessary Priest/Child Safe Officer will contact the child's parents and will arrange support for the child as appropriate.
- •Kooyoora will ask for a written report and consent of the person making complaint.
- Priest/CSO will help to fill out the appropriate form and in writing the complaint, and will help you to sign consent for Kooyoora to proceed in investigating the complaint.
- Priest/CSO will forward the report to Kooyoora.
- Kooyoora will keep you informed of process and outcome.
