ABM PEW REFLECTIONS

Today's Gospel is somewhat mind bending, with a 'wealth' of facets – relating to wealth. The master sacked his manager because of his dishonesty but could not help admiring his ingenuity in seeking to ensure his material future. Jesus' point is that his disciples (including us) are called to practise the same kind of single-mindedness in *spiritual* matters, including generosity towards others – accumulating 'true riches' through growing in our relationship with the Lord, compared with the wealth of this world, which is 'dishonest' because it can fool us into a false security where we are depending on it as central to our life-style. The fact is that the wealth of this world is really only an 'add-on' to our lives – useful for this life only.

- Give thanks for the wealth of resources God provides, and pray that you may serve God *with* your 'wealth'.

THE LEADER

Rev Dr Sally Douglas is the minister at Richmond Uniting Church and an Honary Postdoctoral Research Associate and Associate Lecturer at Trinity Theological College and the University of Divinity. Her doctoral research focused on christology and the potential implications of ancient, often suppressed, understandings of Jesus in contemporary context.

THE TOPIC

Sally Douglas' interdisciplinary research spanning biblical studies and theology excavates early church understandings of Jesus as the Female Divine: Sophia - Woman Wisdom. Dr Douglas will elaborate this evidence and early church motivations for imaging Jesus as Woman Wisdom. The complex reasons that this understanding began to be suppressed in the 2nd and 3rd centuries will also be explored.
