Socks for Anglicare Victoria

Thanks to all the little church mice of St Margaret's who came silently and brought 49 pairs of winter socks for the homeless men who attend St Mark's for breakfast.

Some of the socks and 22 scarves will have been given out at breakfast in the last two days.

In addition the Angels of St Margaret's were busy in crocheting and knitting, and items were taken to Mission House in Fitzroy for distribution:

22 rugs, 6 quilts, an embroidered set of towels, 4 pillow cases, some beanies and 4 coat hangers for adults.

For children: 20 teddies, 12 knitted balls, 3 tiny skirts, 4 little aprons, 4 Tshirts and 29 beanies.

In addition two bags of women's clothing was included for the op shop and a box of foods brought to St Margaret's before the Corona Virus forced the shut down of the church.
