ABM PEW REFLECTION

We read of the Exodus –the way out of the Hebrew people through the Red Sea. We cannot really know what happened that day (indeed there is scant archaeological evidence that Egypt was home to the Hebrews). But that is of little consequence to the meaning of the text: the writer(s) of this story want us to know of God's final victory in a dire situation. The Israelites' liberation from Egypt is described in terms of a birth–through a path, out of water. The theme strongly influenced later biblical tradition for both the Hebrew people as well as for Christians.

- Pray that we might see where God is leading us, so that we might cast off our shackles and walk towards freedom.
- Give thanks for the Anglican Communion Office, and for all the work they do on behalf of Anglicans worldwide.

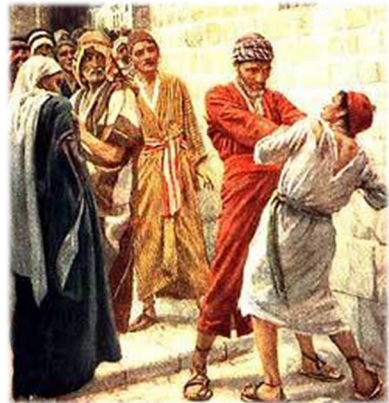
