ABM PEW REFLECTION

Today's OT reading sees Moses talking to the Burning Bush that was not consumed by the flames. At the end of the passage we read that God's name is I AM-note the present tense -the living God. If you were to look at a Greek Orthodoxicon, in the halo around Jesus' head there is almost always the Greek text ὑῶνoften in capital letters, ὉΩΝ. Literally this means 'the being one' but 'he who is' is a better translation. Jesus is God, today, yesterday, for ever.
