Rosters when we resume Sunday services

Owing to COVID and the challenges of maintaining a safe environment, the way we do things in church when we resume Sunday services on 29th November, especially around leading services and communion, will be different.

For the time being the clergy will take care of the set up and pack down for communion, and the leadership of the service - in order to minimise the potential for spread/contamination. This means liturgical assistants and communion assistants are invited to remain in the congregation.

Sidespeople won't need to do all the things they usually do, either, as we can't pass plates around; instead there will be a bowl at the door for any offerings to be made. This arrangement won't be permanent; of course the situation with COVID changes on an almost weekly basis, and when we can resume doing things as we usually do, we shall!

We will still need readers and intercessors and people to operate the AV, so if you're interested in any of these roles and aren't already doing them, please talk to Keren.
