Roles in church

As you'd know, coming out of the COVID lockdown we opted for a cautious approach to who was up the front in church services. With the continued lightening of restrictions, we are looking to reintroduce some new roles - these will be temporary until we can return to normal (having LAs and Communion Assistants etc).

Cross bearers - before each service, starting from this Sunday, the clergy presiding will invite someone from the congregation to carry the cross in, and to carry it out at the end of the service.

Serving - from 23rd May we'll be looking for people who are willing to come up at the Offertory to serve the clergy presiding, and then at the end to assist with washing up the vessels. Christopher and I will be tapping a few folk on the shoulder, but we're also hoping there may be a few of you who are willing to assist in this way from time to time! If you've never done this before, we'll be especially happy to hear from you and to walk you through how/what to do.

COVID19.

If you have a phone that is capable please bring it to church and use the QR codes to check in.


The Government requires as many people as possible to use electronic check- ins.

The Rev. Dr Chris Mulherin is an Anglican minister with a background in engineering, philosophy, and theology. Chris's doctorate in philosophical theology and philosophy of science dealt with the relationship between scientific and other knowledge claims such as those of theology.


