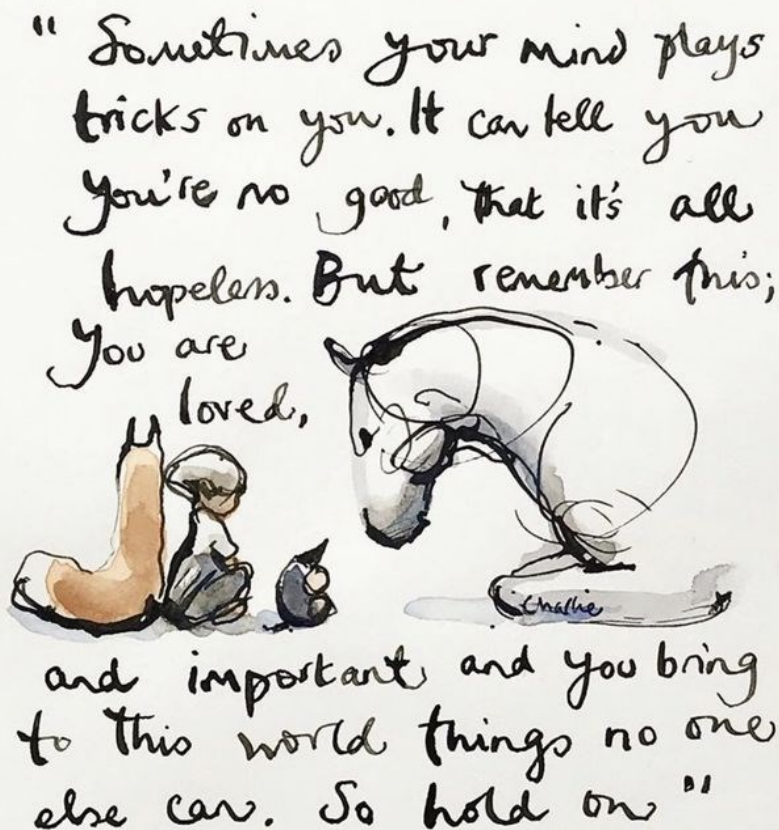
INTERCESSORS WANTED
