Tips on Writing

1. Write it by hand.
2. One letter per person.
3. Address to The Hon. Mr. Scott Morrison.
4. Put your letter in an envelope and gather all the letters from your place of worship together.
5. Be polite.
6. State who you are.
7. If you have a recognised position within your faith community, let them know about it.
8. Tell him in your own words why you are writing to him and outline very briefly one issue, e.g. Electric Vehicles, Renewable Energy etc.
9. Be short and concise.
10. Finish with a question about clear action.
11. Ask for a response.
12. When he replies, don't accept a generic reply, write back.
13. Put in a sealed envelope in the box in the Church Foyer after services.
