

The hand written letters about the urgent need for federal Government policies about mitigating climate change to be in the box in the office by 25<sup>th</sup> July.






#### Tips on Writing

- 4. Put your letter in an envelope and gather all the letters from your place of worship together.
- Be polite.
- 6. State who you are.
- If you have a recognised position within your faith community, let them know about it.
- 8. Tell him in your own words why you are writing to him and outline very briefly one issue, e.g. Electric Vehicles, Renewable Energy etc.
- Be short and concise.
- 10. Finish with a question about clear action.
- 11. Ask for a response.
- 12. When he replies, don't accept a generic reply, write back.
- 13. Put in a sealed envelope in the box in the Church Foyer after services.
