Please support Bronwyn and possibly our last Faith Issues for 2021 by attending if you can.



St Margaret's and HeartEdge


We are partnering with HeartEdge Melbourne (for which St George's East Ivanhoe is the Hub) in offering two exciting opportunities in the coming months:
