- · Printed copy of Immunisation History Statement with ID if not a regular parishioner.
- · Medical Exemption with ID if not a regular parishioner. Please check in with the QR codes if possible, if not there is a paper list available to register your details.



It's that time of year again! We're preparing for the Annual Meeting which this year will be held on Sunday 21st November at 11am.



SPECIAL COLLECTION ON ST MARGARET'S DAY 2021 EASTERN STORM RESCUE AREA PROJECT

In June 2021 fierce storms caused havoc in this area (immediately adjacent to Cockatoo where Christopher is now the priest in charge.) Trees came down, cutting electricity for up to 2 months and causing damage to houses, blocked roads and created mounds of debris.

People and churches in the ranges have helped in the early stages with food parcels and donation of clothing and bed linen. However, the need is still urgent.

174 households still need help. Anglicare Victoria has now been given the task of organizing a fund raising appeal to help clean up the debris and fallen trees that is hindering the rebuilding progress. It will also help those who need assistance with purchasing white goods and larger items.

In October Anglicare Victoria sent out pamphlets to 200 Anglican parishes in Victoria and to the half dozen AVPGs, (formerly Auxiliaries) about the appeal.

St Margaret was known for helping people in trouble and giving shelter to pilgrims. We too can help these people in trouble.

To help 174 households desperately needing help. Donations of \$2 or above are tax deductible. (To claim the tax deduction please put money in envelop with your name and address and AnglicareVic will give receipt Or Make deposit by credit card using we anglicarevic.org.au/donation/emergency-appeal/ and mention St Margaret's.

St Margaret's and HeartEdge


We are partnering with HeartEdge Melbourne (for which St George's East Ivanhoe is the Hub) in offering two exciting opportunities in the coming months:
