#### **ABM PEW REFLECTIONS**

In today's reading from the Old Testament we learn of the meeting between God and Elijah the Prophet at Horeb. It's familiar to many of us because of its use as the basis for one of the verses of the hymn, Dear Lord and Father of Mankind. 
