Faith issues discussion

The next Faith Issues Discussion is on **Monday 6 June 2022** at 7.30pm in the church.

The topic is *The Sarum Mass and the Anglican Prayer Books.* It will led by David Tuke.

The medieval Sarum Mass was the most popular liturgy of the English church prior to reformation. From about 1536 Henry VIII had reforms made to the mass, The first English Prayer book under Edward VI in 1549 made further changes but the Sarum Mass was essentially retained. The second to the fifth, and final prayer book (1662), increasingly became more protestant and more distant from the Sarum Mass. The 1662 Prayer Book remains the authorised liturgy for Anglicans. A fascinating topic and as usual not to be missed. Refreshments follow the discussion. Transport can be arranged.


