Faith issues discussion—cancelled

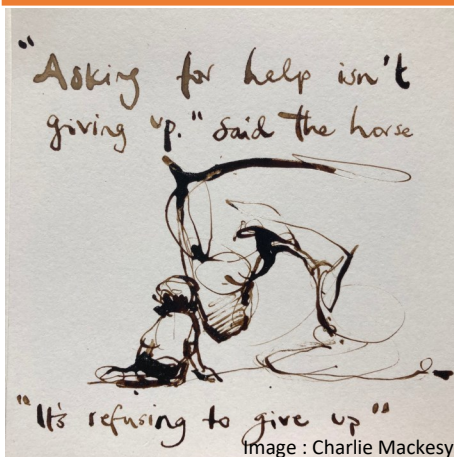
Please be advised that the Faith Issues Discussion scheduled for Monday 1st August at 7.30pm has been cancelled and will be rescheduled for 7th November.
