

*"Muslim Collective is a dynamic Australian faith-based community for progressive thought and social action: a diverse and inclusive group that supports and encourages dialogue about the real issues of our time. We envisage a society where all people - regardless of gender, religion, race, culture or sexuality - can contribute to this conversation respectfully" *.*

Our conversation will feature **Muslim Collective Co-President Iqbal Barkat**, who will speak about MC's aims and objectives, the kind of work that they do and collaborations with interfaith organisations. He will touch upon why such an organisation is required within the contemporary Australian context.



Iqbal is a digital artist, filmmaker and a proponent and practitioner of community and participatory arts. He was born in Singapore where he founded the now disbanded political theatre company, Gung-ho Theatre Ensemble. He teaches screen practice and production at Macquarie University, Sydney.
