LinC Hampers



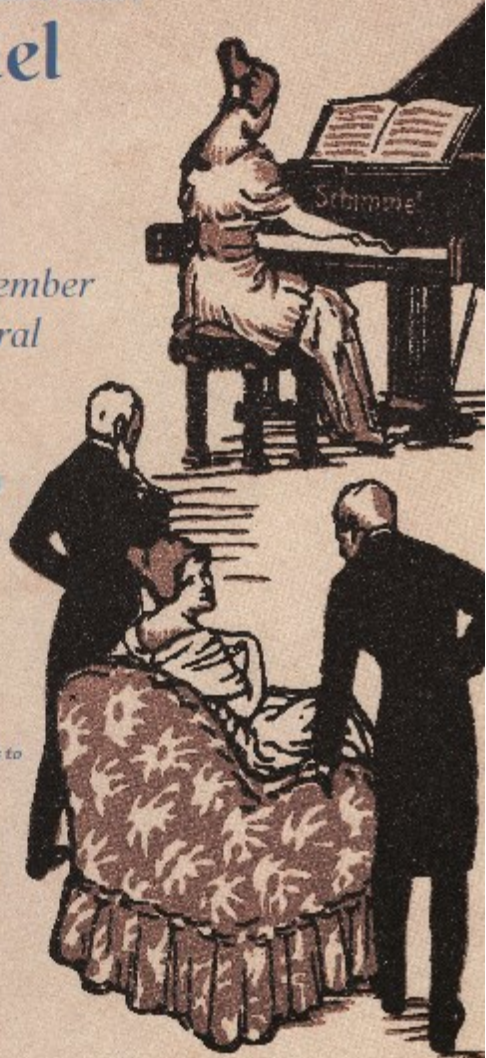
