

Light refreshments will follow. Transport can be arranged.


The topic for discussion is *Egalitarianism and Complementarianism plus GAFCON*

Committee Members: Mary Lynton-Moll (St Meg's Project Officer), Linda Mackenzie, Sally Petty and Liz Pryor.




