ABM PEW REFLECTIONS

John II: 1-45 includes two noteworthy things that may be overlooked. First, Jesus was compassionate. He felt deeply for those affected and acted decisively to help. Second, Jesus interacted with a woman who recognised that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of God, as Peter did in an exchange with Jesus reported in the synoptic gospels. A study of the earliest available Greek text and pertinent early literature by Elizabeth Schrader indicated that the woman was not Martha, but actually Mary Magdalene, the first witness to Jesus' resurrection (*Harvard Theological Review*, 110, 3, July 2017, pp. 360-392; reviewed and summarised by Diana Butler Bass at https://dianabutlerbass.substack.com/p/mary-the-tower).




