

Yvette had spent many years working in the community as a Police Officer with Northumbria Police for 10 years, followed by 2 years as Manager of a Woman's refuge, as a Strategic Domestic Violence Coordinator and a Domestic Violence and Abuse worker. 

Refreshments will follow the discussion. All are urged to attend.


