Charlie Mackesy Images

I first discovered Charlie Mackesy at the beginning of the pandemic and started to include his beautiful cartoons in the Pew Sheet. They have been well received and I have often been asked about him, so I thought you all may like to know a little more about him.

His book “The Boy The Mole the Fox and the Horse” was published in late 2019.

Below is from his Instagram account.

British artist, illustrator and author Charlie Mackesy began his career as a cartoonist for *The Spectator*, before becoming a book illustrator for Oxford University Press. His award-winning work has featured in books, private collections, galleries and public spaces around the world.

Charlie's words and illustrations have brought comfort to many and have been shared online around the world as well as on t-shirts for Comic Relief, magazine covers, street lamp posts, school classrooms, cafés, women's safe houses, prisons, hospital wards and as NHS hospital computer screensavers.

Charlie worked with Richard Curtis on the set of *Love Actually* to create a set of drawings to be auctioned for Comic Relief, and with Nelson Mandela on a lithograph project, *The Unity Series*.

Charlie's paintings have been exhibited widely, most recently in Sotheby's in London.

His bronzes can be found in public spaces in London, including Highgate Cemetery and the Brompton Road. Away from art, Charlie co-runs Mama Buci, a honey social enterprise in Zambia that helps families of low and no income become beekeepers.
