“What is the Epiphany season and why do we celebrate it?”

When you walk into church this Sunday morning you will be met by some very large additions to our nativity scene and slightly smaller additions in front of the altar!

Epiphany also known as “Three Kings Day” is a Christian feast day that is celebrated on 6th January every year.

“Epiphany” comes from the Greek word *epiphaneia*, meaning “manifestation” or “appearance.”

In the western churches, the Epiphany (manifestation) became an occasion to celebrate one element in the story of Christ’s birth, the visit of the far travelled magi (wise men from the East) is understood as the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles (as the men bearing gifts were not Jewish.)

Later tradition fixed the number of men as three – also calling them Kings and naming them Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar .

Because of this, Epiphanytide, (the season of Epipha-

Therefore, there are two 'manifestations'.

This enables us to grasp that Christ came as "a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to (the) people Israel." Luke 2:32

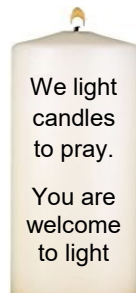
