Prayers for Head Sacristan.

Last week, I shared with our church community that after 28 years of faithful ministry as the head Sacristan of St Margaret's church; Jean Taylor has now chosen that it is now time for her to retire.

Therefore, as a church I now ask that we pray for someone or 'couple' to discern if God maybe nudging them towards this ministry.

Some of the duties include -

- Being in charge of the sacristy and all that is in it;
- Ensuring that all items needed for the various services during the liturgical year is ordered and available;
- Ensuring the alter is adorned correctly;
- Vestments are kept in good order;
- Work with the clergy team on services such as occasional offices.


If you wish to find out more please speak with Jean or myself.
