The issue is **The Society of Friends**, or perhaps better known as the Quakers. It will be led by Geoff Sandy.

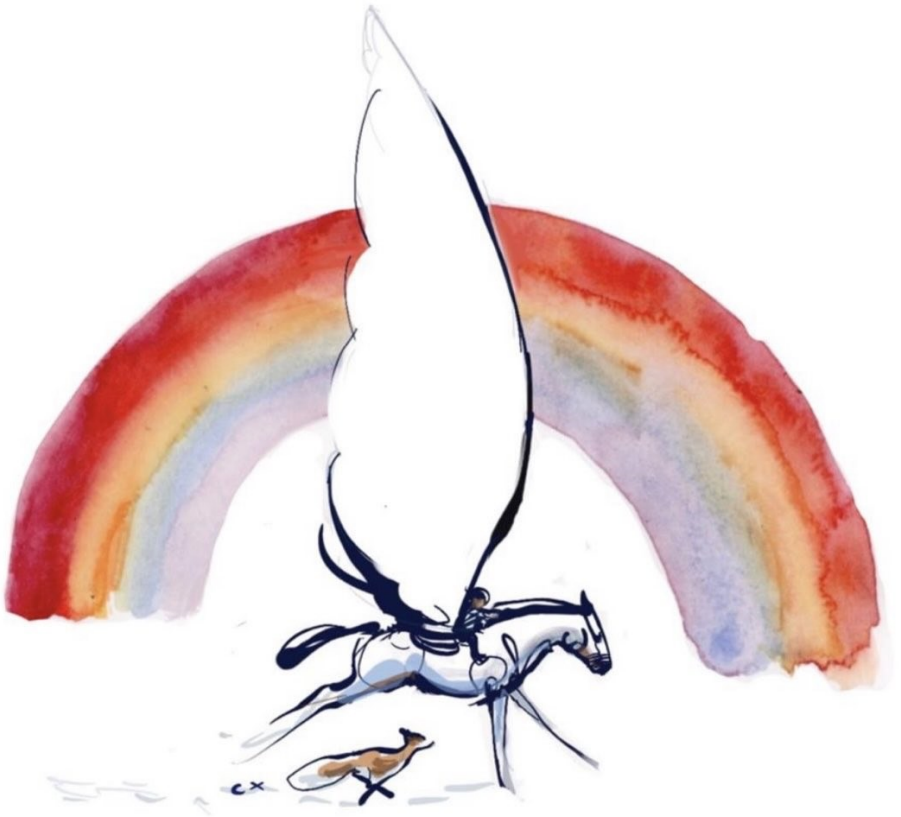
